What can we do for you?

RallyNSW is dedicated to enhancing the sport of Rallying in NSW. We support all those involved, from competitors to event organisers and other officials. This overview outlines the benefits of working with RallyNSW, along with the related responsibilities of event organisers.

From 2019 RallyNSW has provided an Event Liaison Officer to help you through the process of crafting your event, along with a flowchart to help keep your planning and implementation on track.

Media Considerations

One of the primary focuses of RallyNSW is the promotion of events. Each year we invest heavily in promotional media, bringing widespread awareness to each individual event. NSW Rally Championship and (most) East Coast Classic Rally Series events have received significant online video coverage in recent years.

We provide a great deal more than just video coverage, although (video aside) the quality of the promotions we generate is often governed by the information we receive from event teams.

RallyNSW has created a Promotions Guide to help you generate effective exposure. We've also contracted a Media Liaison Officer who will work with your event team to ensure promotions are optimised. We ask that you provide a single point of contact for them to deal with, an Event Media Officer.

Let's see what we can achieve together!

The sky is the limit when we work together as a team. If you feel there is something missing from this document or find that what you need isn't available through RallyNSW, rest assured that others will be in the same situation. If this happens please get in touch through your Event Liaison Officer so we can go about sorting it out. Working together makes life easier for everyone!

Summary of RallyNSW Series

This is intended as a general summary of series only, full details are available in the NSW Rally Competition and Organising conditions, available on the RallyNSW website (<http://www.rallynsw.com.au/competiton-conditions-seeding-lists>).

- NSW Rally Championship (NSWRC), the pinnacle of Rallying in NSW.
- East Coast Classic Rally 2WD Series (ECCRS-2WD), a platform exclusively for two wheel drive classic car owners.
- East Coast Classic Rally 4WD Series (ECCRS-4WD), a platform exclusively for four wheel drive classic car owners.
- Clubman Rally Series (CRS), events aimed at those who want a no-frills, no-fuss environment to compete in.
- Hyundai Rally Series (HRS), a sub-category of the CRS open to those with compliant Hyundai Excel and other PRC Hyundai rally cars.
